MEASURING: Exhibitors are no longer required to submit a copy of their dog's jump height card with their entry or show it the day of the show at check in. It is the sole responsibility of the exhibitor to have their original, official jump height and or temporary jump height form at each trial to present upon request. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running.

PRIZES AND AWARDS: Ribbons will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dog in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. New Title ribbons, AGCH, MACH, PACH, and PAX rosettes and bars will also be awarded. Only one bar will be awarded for a run that earns a PACH and PAX. Prizes must be claimed the day of the trial; none will be mailed.

RUNNING ORDER: Running Order sheets will be posted and will be available online to exhibitors for download after closing. You may print a copy in advance (if desired).

WAIT LIST: This club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the closing date. A maximum of 50 entries will be placed on the wait list. Handlers may opt to run in a higher height division in the Regular program, but not in a lower division than their proper height division. Handlers must run in their proper height division in the Preferred program.

ENTRY: Entry fee is \$20.00/run per dog (includes AKC recording fee)..

Express mail entries **MUST** waive the signature requirement or they will be refused. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on their entry forms, and the correct entry fee. Checks returned due to non-sufficient funds will be assessed a \$30.00 fee. All illegible or incomplete forms or those with insufficient entry fees will be returned.

Electronic entries will be accepted. Email your completed and signed entry form to the trial secretary. A Square invoice will be emailed to you (including a 3.3% + \$0.30 service fee). Notification of entry status prior to closing will be emailed to all exhibitors providing an email address. Any exhibitor that does not have an email address should send a SASE or post card to be returned with their entry status information. No other acknowledgement of entry status will be given. Exhibitors with an email address are responsible for making sure their email address is legible and that any email from the trial secretary is not blocked by spam blockers or rejected due to a full mailbox.

Final entry confirmations and judging schedule will be sent after the final closing date to all exhibitors, as per Chapter 1, Section 19 of the regulations for Agility Trials. Exhibitors providing an email address will be emailed their confirmation, exhibitors with no email address or whose email confirmations bounced, will be sent their confirmations via USPS.

SITE INFORMATION: The agility trial will be held at Adventureetails in Fort Wayne, IN. No overnight RV parking is allowed at this site.

Crating is allowed inside the building, but no flexi-leads. There is ample parking available. There will be NO Thursday night set up; building will open at 7:00AM EST each morning.

NO Flexi-leads are permitted inside the building
PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS! Potty areas will be clearly marked. Anyone caught not picking up after their dog(s) will be asked to leave without a refund

Inside crating is available. Please use mats underneath all crates. Crates may be left overnight; however, SJVAC, Adventureetails and JPAWS Agility Trial Services are not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site. Dogs may **not** be left overnight.

Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend – Multiple Jump Heights Within the Same Trial Day

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

Entering for Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO allows exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is offered in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Handler has 45 seconds for Standard, JWW and Time 2 Beat classes (course time in FAST). Exhibitors must quickly move towards the exit when the horn sounds.
- Dogs may be entered in any level. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).
- Toys are allowed in the ring. Toys must be non-audible and may not leave the handlers hand. Toys that roll freely may not be used.
- Food/treats are not allowed in the ring
- FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and/or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.
- A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time

Fix and Go On (FNG)

As of January 1, 2020, Fix and Go On will be offered on a one-year pilot basis in order to give AKC time to evaluate its impact. FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score. Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

DIRECTION TO TRIAL SITE:

From the South: From I69 take exit 299 onto Lower Huntington/Airport Expressway. Stay on Airport Expressway for 5 miles. Turn left onto Ardmore Ave. Continue for 3.5 mile. Turn right onto Nuttman Ave. Continue 0.4 miles. Turn left onto Stone Blvd.

From the North: From I69 take exit 305, turn left onto IN-14/Illinois Road. Continue for 1.5 miles. Turn left onto W Jefferson Blvd. Continue for 0.1 miles. Turn right onto Ardmore Ave. Continue for 1.4 miles. Turn left onto Nuttman Ave. Continue for 0.4 miles. Turn left onto Stone Blvd.

From South or East: From I-469 exit to Highway 27. On Highway 27, turn west (toward the airport) onto W Ferguson Road. At the airport, Ferguson curves north and becomes Ardmore Ave. Go for 4 miles. Turn right onto Nuttman Ave. Continue 0.4 miles. Turn left onto Stone Blvd.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS: Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, excused, disqualified, or barred from the competition by action of the Show Committee. No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

The Trial Giving Club assumes NO responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Owners/handlers enter at their own risk and agree to assume responsibility for any damage caused by them, their dogs, or their children.

The club reserves the right to remove any animal in distress from a parked vehicle or crate, and all persons attending this agility trial hereby waive any claim for damages against the club for such removal.

Bitches that come into season will have their entry fee refunded less a \$10.00 administrative fee per day. The owner must provide the trial secretary with a signed statement from a veterinarian at least ½ hour before judging begins. No refunds will be made for sick or injured dogs or handlers.

Dogs are not required to be at the trial until the scheduled time of judging; however, handlers arriving after the scheduled course walk through for their class has taken place are not guaranteed a chance to walk the course. All dogs not needed for further judging are excused. The owner/handler is solely responsible for being ready at ringside when the class is to be judged.

All dogs must be on leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up areas. Exhibitors and spectators are expected to keep the show grounds clean. Please pick up after your dogs. Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial weekend with no monies refunded.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine Partners program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
