*Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course without a dog prior to the start of each class*

Entry fees for all regular classes are \$22 per dog per day. All entry fees include the AKC recording fee. Mail Entry/Fees to: Andy Gropp, 9621 Mariners Ridge Drive, Fort Wayne, IN 46819. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$20 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. E-mail confirmations will be sent to those listing a legible e-mail address on the entry form.

### Lab Tested Online Entry Service

This trial is accepting online entries through LabTestedOnline.com. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows. 175 runs online (50%), 175 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48 hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

### After Closing Wait List

SJVAC is offering a Wait List to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing May 20, 2026 at 6 pm. A maximum of 30 entries will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to May 20, 2026 at 6 pm. Any entries withdrawn that are received by May 20, 2026 at 6 pm will be replaced by a wait listed entry, if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by Monday, May 25, 2026 will receive a full refund.

## Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 4<sup>th</sup> place in each jump height in each class (dogs must qualify to receive a placement). Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Double Q ribbons will be awarded. An AGCH/MACH/PACH bar and rosette will be awarded to those dogs earning one at this trial. Exhibitors are asked to notify the trial chair if you could possibly earn one of these titles at this trial. All dogs finishing a title will receive a New Title ribbon. All prizes must be claimed the day of the trial; none will be mailed.

## Jump Height Divisions

Owners/Agents are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. All height divisions will be offered in all of the classes.

**Regular** Exhibitors may choose to enter their dog in a higher height division than required by AKC, but not in a height division lower than the AKC mandated height.

**Preferred** The following jump heights **must** be used in all Preferred Classes.

	REGULAR	PREFERRED
Dogs 11 inches and under at the withers	8 inches	4 inches
Dogs 14 inches and under at the withers	12 inches	8 inches
Dogs 18 inches and under at the withers	16 inches	12 inches
Dogs 22 inches and under at the withers	20 inches	16 inches
Dogs over 22 inches at the withers	24 inches	20 inches
Dogs may be entered at 26" height at their owner's discretion.		

## Entering a Mixture of Regular and Preferred Classes Within the Same Trial Weekend

Effective January 1, 2020, exhibitors may enter a mixture of both Regular and Preferred classes on the same trial day and/or during a trial weekend. Any mixture of Regular and Preferred classes is allowed. Please note that if a dog qualifies in Regular Master Standard and Preferred Master JWW (or vice versa) on the same trial day, then NO Double Q shall be earned toward either the MACH or PACH title. The Double Q still requires that Standard Agility and Jumpers With Weaves be either both Regular OR both Preferred on the same trial day.

Additionally, within the same Regular or Preferred classes, a dog may now be entered in multiple jump heights within the same trial day. For example, the same dog may now be entered in 20-inch Master STD/JWW while also entered in 24C-inch Premier STD/JWW on the same trial day.

A separate entry form must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend.

## Measuring and Height Card Information

When filling out the entry form, designate whether your dog needs to be officially measured. Please check the box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. All dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

### **Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO) Effective July 1, 2024**

- For Exhibition Only will be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, Standard, JWW, Premier and ISC will be 45 seconds. FAST course times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered in any level of FAST (Novice, Open, Excellent, Master). If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Toys are allowed in the ring – they must be non-audible, must not be able to roll freely, and may not leave the handler's hand. Food/treats are not allowed in the ring

### **\*\* NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS \*\***

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form.

In accordance with *AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows*, no dogs under the age of 6 months are allowed on the show site. All AKC rules apply regarding toys and food in the ring.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor, dogs and/or children who create unnecessary disturbances or engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fee paid will be made. Any incidents of dog aggression resulting in harm to other dogs or people that occur within the show grounds will be reported by the Show Committee to the proper authorities.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations for the state in which they are competing.

X-pens and crates may be left over night, but the SJVAC will not be responsible for personal articles left at the site. No grooming is allowed in building and no dogs may be left overnight.

The building will be open for 30 minutes past the last run of the day.

All dogs MUST be on-leash, crated, securely penned, or otherwise under physical control at all times when not competing or at the practice jump. Crating space is limited, please crate in designated areas only.

Dogs are not required to be at the Trial until scheduled time of judging; however, exhibitors are responsible for being at the ringside when it is their turn to run. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up the class. Please check in with the Gate Steward.

Entries are opened upon receipt and exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and LEGIBLE information on entry forms as well as correct fees; illegible or incomplete entries WILL be returned.

There may be no more than **10 dog entry forms** per envelope. Express Mail entries must include YOUR signature permitting them to be left at the Trial Secretary's address or they will be refused

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by means of riot, civil disturbance, fire, or an act of God, emergency, act of public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee.

Refunds: A refund of 100% of the entry fees will be given for any reason, when the request is received by the Trial Secretary in writing or via email prior to closing date.

After closing and prior to the start of the trial, entry fees less \$10.00 per run will be refunded for injured dogs or injured handlers. After closing and prior to the start of the trial, entry fees less \$8.00 per run, will be refunded for bitches in season. A doctor/vet's letter may be required for injuries or bitch in season, at the discretion of the Trial Committee.

Requests for refunds received after the start of the trial will not be given for any reason. No refund will be given for overpayment of less than \$10.00

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

I CERTIFY that I am the actual owner of the dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above.
